PRESIDENT SAYS EUROPE RISKS BEING WIPE AWAY UNLESS IT CHANGES

Trump warns Europe faces 'civilisational erasure'

THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION said on Friday that Europe is facing the "stark prospect of civilisational erasure" and pledged that the United States will support like-minded "patriotic" parties across the continent to prevent a future in which "certain" NATO members will become majority non-European."The dark assessment of Europe's future was released overnight as part of an annual update to the US' national security strategy around the world.

Without naming them directly, the document says the US should support political parties in Europe who fight against migration and promote nationalism. That describes several far-right parties like Reform UK in Britain and the Alternative for Germany, known as the AFD, which has been classified as an extremist party by German

intelligence services. "In everything we do, we are putting America First," Trump wrote in a foreword to the document, which he called a "road map to ensure that America remains the greatest and most successful nation in human history."

In a section called "Promoting European Greatness," the document offers a searing critique of America's closest allies. It warns that Europe is on a path to becoming "unrecognis-

able" because of migration policies that it claims are undermining the national identities of European countries. And it said that it should be the policy of the US to help Europe "correct its current trajectory" over the course of the next several decades.

"We want Europe to remain European, to regain its civilisational self confidence, and to abandon its failed focus on regulatory suffocation," the 33-

page document says.

Trump has made no secret of his disdain for the political leadership in Europe and he has repeatedly pressured them to bend to his will on funding for NATO, trade and tariffs, and other economic matters. Vice President JD Vance issued a broad critique of Europe's mainstream political parties in a speech in Munich in February, and urged them to end the isolation of far-right parties across the continent.

But the document released overnight is the clearest statement yet of how the president wants his America First foreign policy to be a clarion call for other nationalist politicians to overhaul their political systems.

The document accuses the EU and other "transnational bodies" of undermining liberty and sovereignty, censoring free speech, trampling on basic principles of democracy to suppress political opposition and losing their self confidence. —NYT

US sets 2027 deadline for NATO defence

THE US wants Europe to take over the majority of NATO's conventional defense capabilities, from intelligence to missiles, by 2027, Pentagon officials told diplomats in Washington this week, a tight deadline that struck some European officials as unrealistic.

The message, recounted by five sources familiar with the discussion, including a US official, was conveyed at a meeting in Washington of Pentagon staff overseeing NATO policy and several European delegations.

The shifting of this burden from the US to European members of the NATO would dramatically change how the US, a founding member of the post-war alliance, works with its most important military partners. In the meeting, Pentagon officials indicated that Washington was not yet satisfied with the strides Europe has made to boost its defense capabilities since Russia's expanded invasion of Ukraine in 2022.

2000: Time Warner merges with AOL, forming AOL Time Warner, the largest merger in history at the time

1996: Time Warner merges with Turner Broadcasting, gaining Cartoon Network, CNN, TNT and a vast classic film library.

1990: Time Inc merges with Warner Communications in a \$14-billion deal also known as "marriage of content and distribution" creating Time Warner

1972: HBO is founded by Charles Dolan. It was the first US subscription-based cable network

1969: Kinney National Company buys Warner Bros-Seven Arts and later spins off its non-media businesses

1923: Warner Bros was founded by brothers Harry, Albert, Sam and Jack Warner as a film studio in Hollywood

1922: Time Inc was founded to house Time magazine. The first issue of Time magazine was published in March 1923.

2009: ■ Time Warner fully spins off Time Warner Cable, ending its role in cable distribution
■ Time Warner spins off AOL.

2013: Time Warner spins off Time, its magazine division.

2016: AT&T announces acquisition of Time Warner for \$85 billion

2018: AT&T completes its acquisition of Time Warner, renaming it WarnerMedia

2021: AT&T spins off WarnerMedia and merges it with Discovery Inc to create a new media company

2022: WarnerMedia and Discovery complete their merger in a deal valued at \$43 billion deal

X fined €120 mn by EU in first content-law penalty

ELON MUSK'S SOCIAL media company X was fined 120 million euros (\$140 million) by EU tech regulators on Friday for breaching EU online content rules, the first sanction under landmark legislation which will likely draw the US government's ire. Europe's crackdown on Big Tech to ensure smaller rivals can compete and consumers have more choice has been criticised by the administration of US President Donald



Trump, which says it singles out American companies and censors Americans.

The European Commission, the EU's executive, said its laws do not target any nationality and that it is merely defending its digital and democratic standards which usually serve as the

benchmark for the rest of the world. The EU sanction against X followed a two-year-long investigation under the bloc's Digital Services Act (DSA), which requires online platforms to do more to tackle illegal and harmful content.

The EU's investigation of ByteDance's social media app TikTok led to charges in May that the company had breached a DSA requirement to publish an advertisement repository allowing researchers and users to detect scam advertisements. —REUTERS

Even when US President Donald Trump made a landmark visit to China early during his first term in 2017 and Xi lavished him with a private dinner within Beijing's Forbidden City. But despite the apparent bonhomie between Xi and Macron, the French president's visit so

far has resulted in little beyond bolstering Beijing's diplomatic credentials, as world leaders turn to China seeking economic assurances due to Trump's tariffs, analysts say. It has also provided Macron with a chance to project statesmanship after a tough summer in domestic politics.

Investors are watching to see whether a day that began with Macron surprising fellow joggers in the city's Jincheng Lake Park, before joining Xi at a historic dam site, will end with major commercial deals, given that Macron has been joined on his fourth state visit to China by the heads of some of France's biggest firms. —REUTERS
